We had a fabulous trip to the apple orchard on Tuesday!! Thank you to all of our parent chaperones! We even did a little taste testing of things made from apples on Friday. Ask your child about it! Next week our focus will be:

Topic—the season of autumn, Fire Safety (We had a visit from the firemen this week!), and words all around us we can read (environmental print)—on cereal boxes, labels, bags, store and restaurant signs . . .

Letter—Ee, Ff (recognizing it, its sound, and <u>correctly</u> <u>writing it</u>)

Words-mom, dad, green

Math—counting to 30, writing the numbers 1-9 correctly, shapes, and sorting things into groups Patterning—ABABAB patterns

Reading—beginning sounds, the idea of a word vs. a letter, and counting the syllables/beats in a word Nursery Rhyme—Humpty Dumpty
